Kuuskajaskari features an old fort and brand-new cottages. The easy-to-walk trails of Reksaari and Nurmes are perfect for those seeking a peaceful nature experience.

VISIT THE ARCHIPELAGO RESPONSIBLY

- Enjoy the beautiful archipelago scenery with respect for nature and the special characteristics of the archipelago. Take note of the summarised tips for outdoor etiquette and always check the detailed rules of your excursion destination as well.
- Protect the nature in the archipelago by using the marked trails and paths. Signposts and waymarking will guide your way.
- Keep pets on a lead.
- Camping is only permitted at designated sites.
- Fires are only allowed at marked campfire sites. The person lighting a fire is always responsible for ensuring fire safety and extinguishing the fire. All open fires are forbidden when a wildfire warning is in effect.
- No littering: take your rubbish back to an appropriate waste disposal point. Be prepared to take away everything you brought along.

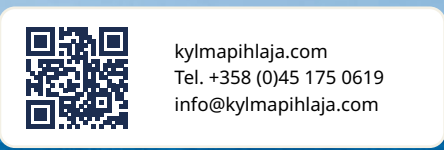
KYLMÄPIHLAJA

The lighthouse island of Kylmäpihlaja is an unforgettable destination located at the edge of the open sea. The sturdy, square lighthouse tower rises 36 metres above sea level. The tower offers a stunning vantage point to admire the surrounding seascapes.

On the ruggedly beautiful lighthouse island, visitors can stay in the unique accommodation within the lighthouse tower or in the scenic cabins located on the rocky shore. The island also features a restaurant, a café, saunas, hot tubs, and a sheltered harbour for sailors.

KUUSKAJASKARI

The history of Kuuskajaskari as a military fortress has left its mark on the landscape of the forested island. Along the hiking trail around the island, you will find old defence structures ranging from trenches to coastal cannons. The seascapes are worth admiring from the cliffs or the observation tower.

Accommodation, restaurant and café services, and a popular guest harbour can be found on the island. You can also go swimming and enjoy the warmth of the sauna on Kuuskajaskari.

NURMES

The nature of the largest island in the Rauma archipelago is diverse, and its cultural environment is rich. The life of bygone islanders is easily observed at old islander farms and sheep pastures. The island has over 15 kilometers of hiking trails.



REKSAARI

Reksaari is a great destination for a family excursion. There are also hiking trails around the island, along which you can discover the diverse flora and birdlife of the archipelago.

Rohela's old fisherman's cottage is located on the island and is used as a reservable hut. The island can also be reached from the mainland at Omenapuunmaa by borrowing a rowboat.



Archipelago hiking trails and the magnificent nature of the National Park

There are up to 30 kilometres of marked hiking trails in the Rauma archipelago. There are also trails in the areas of the Bothnian Sea National Park. The four islands and the accommodation and lodging options in the archipelago make it possible to spend several days hiking and enjoying nature, but short day trips along easy nature trails are also possible.
