

NUCLEAR POWER AND RAUMA'S VARIOUS INDUSTRIES – example group program

Program

9:30 AM	Arrival at the Olkiluoto Visitor Center. The visit begins with coffee service and a small snack. After coffee, there is time to explore the "Electricity from Uranium" exhibition. At approximately 10:15 AM, a company presentation will be held, during which an Olkiluoto employee will introduce the operations of the facility. Following the presentation, around 11:00 AM, a bus tour of the nuclear power plant area will commence. An Olkiluoto employee will accompany the bus tour, which lasts approximately 45 minutes and ends back at the Visitor Center. Departure from the Visitor Center towards Rauma at approximately 11:45 AM.
12:15 PM	A delicious lunch at Restaurant Fööri, located within the Sytytin Technology Center.
1:15 PM	After lunch, the day continues with a guided bus tour exploring Rauma's industry and maritime history. The guided tour departs from in front of Restaurant Fööri.
2:15 PM	After the bus tour, there will be a visit to the fascinating Rauma Maritime Museum. This specialized museum highlights the essential elements that have sustained the medieval city: the sea and seafaring. The visit includes a guided tour.
3:30 PM	Afternoon coffee at Restaurant Savila, located in a charming wooden house on the edge of Old Rauma. Coffee/tea and a snack will be served. The journey home begins at approximately 4:15 PM.
