

OLD RAUMA AND SAMMALLAHDENMÄKI – example group program

Program

10:00 AM	Arrival in Rauma. The day in Rauma begins with morning coffee at Restaurant Savila, located in a charming wooden house right next to Old Rauma.
10:50 AM	After coffee, the group will continue with a guided walking tour through the narrow and picturesque streets of Old Rauma, a UNESCO World Heritage site. The tour provides fascinating insights into the area's rich history and present-day life. During the tour, visitors will also explore a local home museum that showcases life in Old Rauma over a hundred years ago.
12:45 PM	A traditional lapskoussi lunch will be served at Restaurant Etappi*22*. Lapskoussi is a traditional Rauma dish, brought to the town by sailors. Its secret lies in the slow-cooked tender meats, root vegetables, and spices. Vegetarian option is also available. After lunch, the journey continues to Rauma's Lappi Village, approximately 20 km away.
2:45 PM	A visit to Rauma's second UNESCO World Heritage site, Sammallahdenmäki. A guide will introduce the Bronze Age burial cairn area, ancient burial practices, and the myths and legends about the site. The trails run through beautiful forest scenery. The return trip can begin around 4:15 PM.
