

OLD RAUMA AND THE SEA – example group program

Program

9:00 AM	Arrival in Rauma. The day in Rauma begins with traditional morning coffee at the Rauma Market Square, located in the heart of the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Old Rauma. The coffee is served from a small cart, and it is called “pystökaffe” in Rauma dialect, as in “standing coffee”. As the name suggests, the coffee is enjoyed while standing.
9:30 AM	After the morning coffee, the exploration of Old Rauma continues with a guided walking tour. During the tour, participants will learn about the unique area's history and present day. If possible, the tour includes a visit to the beautiful Church of the Holy Cross.
11:20 AM	Departure for an archipelago cruise (private charter) to Kuuskajaskari. The sea journey takes approximately 30 minutes one way. The former fortress island offers plenty to see, such as coastal artillery, maritime observation towers, trenches, and of course, stunning nature.
11:50 AM	Upon arrival at Kuuskajaskari, a delicious salmon soup lunch will be served, followed by free time to explore the island.
2:00 PM	Departure back to the mainland, with an estimated arrival at 2:30 PM.
2:30 PM	Enjoy afternoon coffee with a sweet pastry at Marina Vista, located right by the harbor at Syväraumanlahti.
3:15 PM	A guided tour of the fascinating Rauma Maritime Museum, which offers extensive information on Rauma's maritime history. After the tour, departure for the return journey at approximately 4:00 PM.
