## OLD RAUMA AND THE SEA – example programme

### Programme

9.00 am	Arrival in Rauma.  The day in Rauma starts with a traditional morning coffee enjoyed standing up ( <i>pystökaffe</i> ) at the market place in the heart of the UNESCO World Heritage site Old Rauma
9.30 am	A guided walking tour in the idyllic Old Rauma starts after the morning coffee. The guide tells about the interesting past and the present of the area, and a visit to the Church of the Holy Cross is included if possible.
11.20 am	Departure towards the fortress island of Kuuskajaskari (duration of the journey 30 minutes). The former fortress island has lots to see; military attractions, such as cannons, two surveillance towers, trenches, shooting ranges, and of course, beautiful nature.
11.50 am	After arriving in Kuuskajaskari, lunch of lapskoussi (lapscouse), a traditional dish, is enjoyed. Lapskoussi was brought to Rauma by sailors and the secret of the dish is in the ingredients: tender meat, root vegetables and spices. After lunch, a guide introduces the island.
1.50 pm	Departure back to the shore, arrival in Rauma at 2.20 pm.
2.40 pm	A guided tour in Rauma Maritime Museum. The historical building showcases the rich history of seafaring in Rauma.  After the guided tour, the journey home can begin at 4 pm.
