SHOPPING AND NATURE IN LAPPI VILLAGE – example programme

Programme

10.00 am	Arrival in the village of Lappi in Rauma. The day starts with a morning coffee at Pyörni café and gift shop, which is full of charming handicrafts, gifts and decorations.
11.00 am	A visit to Eskimo factory outlet, where you will find plenty of products needed for cooking, baking and cleaning.
12.00 noon	A lunch in Kivikylän Kotipalvaamo, a Finnish producer of meat and poultry meat products. The story of the company is told during the visit and there is time for some shopping in the factory outlet as well.
1.30 pm	A guided tour in the peace of the forest, at the Bronze Age burial site Sammallahdenmäki. The site was accepted to the Unesco World Heritage list as the first archaeological site in Finland.
2.45 pm	Tasting of honey products by Polar Honey Finland (Lappi-Hunaja), a well-known Finnish honey producer. The products cannot be found in supermarkets, so this is a great chance to shop for some presents.

Journey home begins at 3.30 pm.
