OLD RAUMA AND THE SEA – example programme for groups

Programme

9.00 am	Arrival to Rauma. The day in Rauma starts with a traditional Pystökaffee, morning coffee , which is enjoyed standing up at the Market place in the heart of the UNESCO World Heritage site Old Rauma.
9.30 am	A guided walking tour in the idyllic Old Rauma starts after the morning coffee. The guide tells about the interesting past and the present of the area, and a visit to the Church of the Holy Cross is included if possible.
11.20 am	A Charter cruise from the mainland to the the fortress island of Kuuskajaskari . The journey takes 30 minutes. The former fortress island has lots to see; military attractions, such as cannons, two surveillance towers, trenches, and of course, beautiful nature.
11.50 am	Delicious fish soup lunch is available in the restaurant. After the lunch, you have time to explore the island.
1.50 pm	Departure back to the mainland, arrival in Rauma at 2.20 pm.
2.40 pm	A guided tour in Rauma Maritime Museum . The historical building showcases the rich history of seafaring in Rauma. After the guided tour, the day in Rauma ends about at 4 pm.
