THE IDYLLIC LACE TOWN – example programme for groups

Programme

10.00 am	Arrival to Rauma. The day starts with a traditional pystökaffe, morning coffee enjoyed standing up, at the lively Market place in the heart of UNESCO World Heritage site Old Rauma.
10.30 am	After the morning coffee, a 2-hour guided walking tour introduces Old Rauma and the tradition of bobbin lace making in Rauma. The guide tells interesting stories about the past and the present of the area. Bobbin lace is further introduced in the lace shop Pits-Priia and in the Old Town Hall Museum. Pits-Priia is a lace shop run by Nyplääjät ry (Lace-makers' Association) where you can see a lace-maker making lace and you can buy various lace products. The museum destination, the Old Town Hall , exhibits plenty of lace from Rauma and many different bobbin lace patterns. The museum shop offers a possibility to buy lace products.
12.45 pm	An abundant buffet lunch in Villa Tallbo Restaurant . The restaurant is located in a charming old villa by the sea.
2.30 pm	A guided tour in Teresia and Rafael Lönnström's Home Museum . The museum showcases the unique home and the art collection of the industrialist couple from Rauma. The day in Rauma ends about at 3.30 pm.
