


Lace week 22.-30.7.2023

MAP LOCATIONS

1 THE OLDEST CAIRNS AND KIRKONLAATTIA

The small cairn at the highest point in the area (43 metres above sea level) dates back to 1300 BCE. The largest and most famous ancient cairn Kirkonlaattia takes its name from an old folk tale. Its structure is quadrangular and its walls are almost 20 metres long. The height of the ruin is only about half a metre.

2 CAIRNS ON THE EDGE OF THE ROCKY SLOPE

The view from the cairns is a landscape of open fields where the sea was located during the Bronze Age. As a result of post-glacial land uplift, the distance to the seashore is currently about 20 kilometres. Proximity to the sea was an essential consideration when the site for the burial cairns was first chosen.

3 BARROWS

Sammallahdenmäki features several different types of cairns, for example small, low oval cairns, large barrows, and ring cairns. The large cairns in the middle of the area are shaped like barrows.

4 SPIRAL CAIRN



The spiral pattern may have symbolised the sun and cremating the dead may have been associated with sun worship. Cremated bones have been found in the cairn.

5 THE HUILU LONG RUIN

The Huili ("Flute") long ruin takes its name from its shape. Three distinct burials can be identified in this over 20-metre-long cairn.


6 BOULDER CAIRN

This grave contained the only fragment of material found in the area. A small fragment of a bronze bracelet was found among the cremated bone fragments. Objects are rarely found in Bronze Age burial cairns.



Rauma lace

Lace-making is an old tradition in Rauma. Lace products are very popular souvenirs. You will find lace products from the boutiques of Old Rauma. Especially Old Town Hall museum shop has a wide range of lace products. For example, a lace bookmark or a lace jewellery is a great memento of the visit in the lace city.



Sea-salty experiences in the archipelago

Rauma archipelago is the heart of the Bothnian Sea National Park. Water buses run daily during the summer, allowing everyone to enjoy maritime experiences. Water buses and taxi boats can take you to the Kylmäpihlaja lighthouse island, Kuuskajaskari fortress and holiday island and the lovely nature trails of Reksaari.
