OLD RAUMA AND SAMMALLAHDENMÄKI – an example programme for groups

Programme

9:30 am Arrival to Rauma.

The day starts with a morning coffee in a unique café in Old Rauma.

10:50 am After the morning coffee, it is time to get to know about the beautiful **Old**

Rauma. During the guided walking tour along the narrow streets, the guide tells interesting stories and facts about the UNESCO world herit-

age site's history and present day.

The guiding also includes a visit to one of the **home museums** of the area, which portrays the life of Old Rauma over a hundred years ago.

12:45 pm After the guiding is time to enjoy a traditional lobscouse lunch at the

Restaurant Etappi *22*. The sailors were the first to introduce lobscouse (lapskoussi in Finnish) to the people of Rauma, and it has become a very traditional dish. Lobscouse is made from long cooked pork, beef and vegetables. It is served with pickles and sliced beetroot and

crowned with melted butter.

After lunch, it is time to travel to **Lappi Village**, about 20 km from the

city.

2:45 pm A visit to Rauma's other UNESCO world heritage site **Sammal-**

lahdenmäki. Get to know the Bronze Age burial cairns with a guide.

The paths zigzag through beautiful woodland area.

The excursion comes to an end around 4:15 pm.
